The successful candidate will be a self-starter with a great personality, passionate about serving youth in an educational setting, and the ability to build relationships with 1st – 8th grade students. The Behavior Support Intern's mission is to ensure that youth have a positive and healthy after-school experience and are crucial to a successful after-school program. The Behavior Support Intern will work to expose ASAS students to new concepts in learning and help them develop a stronger sense of social responsibility and civic awareness.

The successful candidate will be detail-oriented and a self-starter with strong leadership, organizational, management and communication skills. The Behavior Support Intern should exemplify ASAS's core values: *entrepreneurial, proactive, transparent, collaborate, and accountable*.

- Ability to work cooperatively and collaboratively with program staff, school staff, parents and families, and community leaders
- Skilled in data tracking, record keeping, writing reports, and maintain student and staff



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- Ability to communicate effectively and demonstrate sensitivity to others as well as respond to critical incidents and act swiftly in an emergency situation
- Familiarity and experience with diverse populations, culture competencies, and youth principles is strongly desired
