

APPLICATION-IF YOU PASSED ALL OAE EXAMS

- × Effective Year (July 2020)
- × Four Year Resident Educator license
 - + Second license-could be Five Year Professional
- × \$160 payable by electronic check or credit card
- × Do not have to send transcripts
- × Takes 2-4 weeks to process

REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSURE

- ✘ Successful completion of all coursework
 - + Wait until final grades are posted to apply
- ✘ Successful completion of all required OAE exams
- ✘ Successful completion of TaskStream Portfolio
- ✘ BCI/FBI background check completed within the last year

APPLICATION-COVID-19

- × ODE to issue temporary **ONE-YEAR** licenses starting **May 15, 2020** to applicants who have not complete all required OAE tests.
- × BCI/FBI completed within a year is **STILL** required

BCI/FBI-COVID-19

- ✘ Electronic Fingerprinting (**Preferred Option**)
 - + Visit <https://www.ohioattorneygeneral.gov/Business/Services-for-Business/WebCheck/Webcheck-Community-Listing> to find an open fingerprint location near you.
 - + Results are usually back within 72 hours.
 - + ****Before traveling to any location please call to verify they are providing fingerprinting services at this time. ****

- ✘ Local Police / Sheriff Office: Contact your local Police Department or Sheriff's Office to inquire if they offer fingerprinting services.

- ✘ At Home Fingerprint Collection
 - + Visit the Ohio Attorney General's Office for instructions on how to complete fingerprints at home. <https://www.ohioattorneygeneral.gov/Files/Forms> - scroll down to Background Checks. Click on the BCI and/or FBI Fingerprint Card links and follow the directions.
 - + ****Please note this option will take 30 days to process and if prints are not inked correctly they will be sent back and the 30 days will start over. ****
