
COMPLETER LICENSING

Beginning September 1, 2013, the Ohio Assessments for Educators tests have been a licensure requirement for all initial licensure programs in Ohio. All candidates take one test of Applied Professional Knowledge (APK) and one or more content tests. This evidence document provides a snapshot summary of CSU initial licensure candidate performance by test over a three-year period and compares these results with candidate results statewide. Each year, faculty engage in analysis of the individual test scores disaggregated to the domain and competency levels, to identify potential areas for curriculum modification or enhancement.

As demonstrated in the following summary table, high percentages of Cleveland State completers in initial and advanced programs pass their licensure exams. Of the 162 initial 2018-2019 Title II program completers, 148 have passed their licensure tests, representing a 91% pass rate, compared with 85% for the previous year.

At the initial preparation level, pass rates for the Assessment of Professional Knowledge range from 73% to 100%. Pass rates for individual content area tests range from 57% to 100%. As shown in the chart below, passing rates in 12 out of 17 initial licensure tests have improved or remained at 100% since 2017-2018. At the advanced level, the 2018-2019 pass rate for the Educational Leadership test is 75%.
