## COMPLETER LICENSING

Beginning September 1, 2013, the Ohio Assessments for Educators tests have been a licensure requirement for all initial licensure programs in Ohio. All candidates take one test of Applied Professional Knowledge (APK) and one or more content tests. This evidence document provides a snapshot summary of CSU initial licensure candidate performance by test over a three-year period and compares the most recent two years of results with candidate results statewide. Each year, faculty engage in analysis of the individual test scores disaggregated to the domain and competency levels, to identify potential areas for curriculum modification or enhancement. This year, test scores for advanced licensure and teaching endorsements have been added as a separate table.

At the initial preparation level, pass rates for the Assessment of Professional Knowledge range from $70 \%$ to $94 \%$. Pass rates for individual content area tests range from $63 \%$ to $100 \%$. Although there was a slight drop in the pass rates for nine exams, the overall pass rate for APK exams was calculated as $84.57 \%$, and the overall pass rate for content exams was $84.80 \%$, exceeding the CAEP-required $80 \%$ pass rate. We are also pleased to report the pass rate in 3 out of 4 middle grades content exams increase, since that has been the focus of a targeted effort in middle grades content courses.

At the advanced level, the 2019-2020 pass rates ranged from $84 \%$ to $100 \%$, although this data does not include all completers and should be interpreted with caution because candidates who are not immediately applying for a new license or endorsement may opt not to take the exam before program completion.
