## COMPLETER LICENSING

Beginning September 1, 2013, the Ohio Assessments for Educators tests have been a licensure requirement for all initial licensure programs in Ohio. All candidates must pass one test of Applied Professional Knowledge or achieve a state passing score on the edTPA. In addition, they are required to take one or more content tests. This evidence document provides a snapshot summary of CSU initial licensure candidate performance by test over a three-year period and compares the most recent two years of results with candidate results statewide. Each year, faculty engage in analysis of the individual test scores disaggregated to the domain and competency levels, to identify potential areas for curriculum modification or enhancement. This year, test scores for advanced licensure and teaching endorsements have been added as a separate table.

At the initial preparation level, pass rates for the Assessment of Professional Knowledge range from $83 \%$ to $100 \%$ although it should be noted that candidates only take the APK if they did not receive a state passing score on the edTPA. Pass rates for individual content area tests range from $67 \%$ to $100 \%$. There is greater fluctuation in pass rates for exams with fewer completers. For the initial licensure exams, the pass rate increased or stayed the same in 7 out of 17 exams and met or exceeded state pass rates in 11 exams. In the middle grades content exams, we maintained increases from last year in mathematics, maintained similar levels in language arts and science, and saw a rebound of social studies scores after a decrease last year. These content tests continue to be an area of focus.

At the advanced level, the 2021-2022 pass rates ranged from $75 \%$ to $100 \%$, although this data does not include all completers and should be interpreted with caution because candidates who are not immediately applying for a new license or endorsement may opt not to take the exam before program completion.
