

8 Hour OSHA Hazardous Material HAZWOPER Awareness

Course Description:

This 8-hour OSHA HAZWOPER Awareness training is critical for employees who may discover a hazardous substance release, or be present when a release occurs. These employees must know their responsibilities for alerting the proper personnel and clearing the area to make room for an effective, organized emergency response.

This course is intended for all general site workers who remove hazardous waste or who are exposed or potentially exposed to hazardous substances or health hazards. The course requirements are based upon the (OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120 for private sector) and (NFPA for public sector) programs. This program is designed for initial training and meets the applicable OSHA & NFPA annual refresher requirements.

Course Objectives:

- OSHA 1910.120 (q) Requirements
- Fire Behavior of Hazardous Materials
- Safety Data Sheets
- Hazardous Material Identification System
- Emergency Response

Who should attend?

- Industrial safety personnel
- Drivers and carriers of dangerous goods
- Supervisory personnel
- Hazardous waste site workers
- First line security personnel
- Employees involved in shipping and receiving
- First line employees in the transportation process
- Any workers who perform cleanup, emergency response, or corrective actions that involve the uncontrolled release of hazardous substances.
