The City of East Cleveland, Department of Community Development provides a range of programs and services designed to strengthen the community's housing, to ensure a suitable living environment. Community Development also works to expand economic development opportunities. Community Development works with other City departments, the County, and community-based non-profit organizations to improve the quality of life for residents and businesses.

Internship Description
