The Office of Civic Engagement at Cleveland State University Joins over 3,500 Partners Nationwide in Massive Push to Register Voters on September 24

WHAT:

At 11:00 am, Tuesday, September 24, 2019, *The Office of Civic Engagement and its partners* will join over <u>3,500</u> <u>partners nationwide</u> in hosting a National Voter Registration Day 2019 event on the Second Floor of the Student Center at Cleveland State University as part of a massive 50-state effort to register thousands of voters.

WHY:

The goal for this year's annual National Voter Registration Day is to increase participation in the 2019 midterm and state elections across the country by encouraging Americans to register to vote and make their voices heard at the ballot box. While presidential elections get the media attention, "off-year" elections are a chance for voters to elect men and women who will have immediate impacts on their daily lives – from governors to mayors [In *your town, county, state* important elections are happening including *insert information on local elections*]. Started in 2012 for the presidential election, National Voter Registration Day is designed to create an annual moment when the entire nation focuses on registering Americans to exercise their most basic right – the right to vote.
