The Ohio Certified Public Manager® (OCPM) Program is a comprehensive and nationally certified development program for state and local government leaders. Cleveland State University's Center for Public & Nonprofit Management delivers the official CPM certification program for the state of Ohio. To receive the OCPM credential, participants must enroll in and successfully complete the Public Management Academy and Leadership Academy. Cleveland State University received accreditation to administer the program in 2020.

PUBLIC MANAGEMENT ACADEMY

Public Management Academy (PMA) is a one-year, comprehensive program allowing managers to sharpen their supervisory and management skills and build their public sector toolkit. Participants engage in 19 customized workshops and an individual or group project.

Leadership Academy (LA) is the premier public sector leadership development program in the region including modules on leadership styles, change management, generations in the workplace, power & persuasion, knowledge transfer, strategic planning, crisis communications, and more.
