IMPACT ON STUDENT LEARNING AND TEACHER PERFORMANCE

The following data was published in the Ohio Educator Preparation Performance Report in February 2021 and includes data from all program completers with effective license years of 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019. This data is prepared annually by the Ohio Department of Higher Education for all teacher preparation programs in the state.

Due to the COVID pandemic in Spring 2020, the state of Ohio suspended student testing as well as data collection used to generate some of this data. Therefore, data from the 2020 report is not comparable to previous years, so we have left the previous two years in the report for comparison.

Although we do not have 2020 data to verify this, the historical trend for Cleveland State candidates as shown in the 2019 and 2018 data is to receive comparable value-added and OTES scores as completers from comparable universities while also accepting teaching positions in high minority and high poverty schools. In 2020, the EPP-wide Title II exam pass rate increased to 91%, which may reflect recent efforts to provide additional candidate test preparation and increased focus on test content in our courses.
