## IMPACT ON STUDENT LEARNING AND TEACHER PERFORMANCE

The following data was published in the Ohio Educator Preparation Performance Report in February 2021 and includes data from all program completers with effective license years of 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021. This data is prepared annually by the Ohio Department of Higher Education for all teacher preparation programs in the state.

In 2021, 72% of CSU graduates working in Ohio schools earned a Skilled or Accomplished rating in the Ohio Teacher Evaluation System (OTES). Due to the COVID pandemic, the state of Ohio suspended student testing as well as data collection used to generate value-added data. Because the 2020 and 2021 reports are not complete, we have left the previous two years in the report for comparison.

The historical trend for Cleveland State candidates as shown in the 2019 and 2018 data is to receive comparable value-added and OTES scores as completers from comparable universities while also accepting teaching positions in high minority and high poverty schools, although we do not have 2020 or 2021 data to confirm that this trend has continued. After rising to 91% in 2020, the Cleveland State EPP-wide Title II exam pass rate decreased to 68% in 2021. Our interpretation of this pass rate is that testing centers were disrupted in 2020 by the COVID pandemic. Candidates who had not passed their tests prior to that time were unable to retake tests and were eligible for temporary COVID licenses which did not require passing test scores. We have already seen an increase in pass rates for completers who took tests after this year.
